

Emergency Medical Procedures at SCF Softball Field

Updated: 11/02/17

1. Determine if the injured person needs outside medical attention as soon as possible – bleeding, unconscious, broken bones, heart, etc.
2. If Emergency Medical Assistance is needed:

CALL 911 for FIRE/AMBULANCE

The SCF Softball Field has a red Emergency telephone box located on the east side of the grandstand wall and just outside the storage room double door.

Open the box - instructions are on the inside of the phone box door.

- **Pick up the phone and dial 911.**
 - **An operator will ask what the emergency is, where the caller is located, and the phone number you are calling from:**

3. While waiting for help to arrive, please make sure the street next to the field/grandstand area is clear of any cars/golf carts that may be parked against the red curbs or in the middle of the street. This gives emergency vehicles easier access/ability to quickly turn around and transport the injured.

When help shows up, have someone meet the vehicles (fire or ambulance) at the curb and direct them to where the individual needing help is located.

4. Before help arrives, determine if there is anyone at the SCF Softball Field with a medical background who can help (doctor, nurse, fire, police, first responder)
5. The SCF Softball Medical Kit will be near the 1st base dugout. The Black medical kit has first aid items, disinfectant wash and cream, bandages, gauze, wipes, band aids, scissors, tape, rubber gloves, etc.
6. A SCF Heart Defibrillator will be near the 1st base dugout. The defibrillator has instructions in it and prompts the user as to what to do if the injured person's heart is not beating.
7. If necessary, contact the SC Festival HOA Office and advise there has been a serious injury (or death). **928-252-2100 or 928-252-2104**
8. If injuries require outside medical assistance, please complete the **SCF Incident/Accident Report** form (forms located in the Softball Field Storage room). The Club's Safety Chairman will be responsible for completing/reviewing the form and submitting it to the HOA. A copy will be retained in the Club's records.
