

as necessary. Teams are limited to 15 players. Tier 2 and 3 teams play with 11 players defensively while Tier 1 plays with 10 players. The Club provides a uniform jersey.

WOMEN'S LEAGUE (WL): New for 2019 season is the Women's League (WL). The SCF team is called Fireballs. It is a women only team that plays against other communities women's teams on Saturdays. At this point in time everyone plays but in the future, as more players join, there may be a team draft. The Board approved coaches (managers) will schedule practices and team playing. The Club provides a uniform jersey.

SUMMER SEASON

During the summer months, the Club organizes a Summer league. The Summer league is open to all Club members, and teams are composed of all 3 skill levels. SCF teams play against other senior community teams. Day and time are determined by Board/membership. Games usually start earlier due to heat (7:30am). In early spring, the Club secretary will send out an email to membership about participating in the summer league. Those members who respond that they wish to participate will be put on a team with Club board approved coaches (managers). Coaches will schedule practices.

OPEN PRACTICE: Typically, summer is the only time that there is a scheduled open practice for any member on Fridays starting at 8:00am depending on if there is a coach available to supervise. Winter season may have open practices if the field is available. Check Club calendar on website.

SPECIAL CLUB EVENTS

ANNUAL FUNDRAISER TOURNAMENT: The Club hosts a tournament the last two weeks in January to raise funds for the Club. There is an entry fee of \$350. The tournament is open to SCF SB members (organize your own team). Outside communities are invited to enter their own teams for the same fee. The tournament is organized by specific skill levels. Players can always play up in skill level, not down. The tournament is set up as bracket play with seeding games and single elimination play. All Club members are expected to volunteer to help run this tournament as it raises \$3500-\$6000 for the Club. Additional information will be forthcoming as event is organized by the Tournament Director.

STATES TOURNAMENT: The Club hosts an in-house tournament in March. Members enter the tournament with a minimal fee and are divided into geographical teams and all skill levels are mixed. At this time there are 6 teams: Canada, West, East, Central, Mid-west, & North. Players are put into each area based on their birth state, working state, college state, or retired state. Additional information will be forthcoming as the event is organized by the Tournament Director.
