The SCF Softball Club is a chartered club under the Sun City Festival Home Owners Association (HOA). We are governed by the SCF HOA Chartered Club Rules and the SCF Softball Club Bylaws. You should familiarize yourself with the club bylaws, they can be found on our club website.

Our Club Bylaws require each new member to go through a player evaluation process. Player ratings help us determine the best leagues for each player based on skill level. You will be notified by the Ratings Chair of the next scheduled ratings session. You must attend before you can sign up for league play. All members who have not been rated are eligible to play as a substitute until rated. **Please note we do not allow long spike shoes (plastic or metal), turf shoes or short spikes are okay.**

You will receive an email invitation to join GroupWorks. This is the web-based tool we use for communicating with our membership. In order to receive messages and to sign up to play, you must establish a GroupWorks account. You should not use a shared email address as GroupWorks determines who you are based on your email address.

Each member is also asked to contribute volunteer time to be eligible to play. Our volunteer activities are; umpire, scorekeeper, field prep, or leadership positions within the club. We provide training for all volunteer positions.
